ESSENTIALS INCLUDE...

RECURRING SESSIONS AT DAYCARE PRIOR TO STAY We require your dog to have attended daycare for a minimum of x6 sessions over the prior 3 months to boarding so that we know your dog inside and out and they feel super comfortable here too!

FIXED DROP OFF & PICK UP TIMINGS

Drop off and pick up timings remain the same as daycare, therefore all drop offs are in the morning and all pick ups are in the evenings for boarders as well.

Therefore you may need to allow for an additional day dependent on when you are setting off/returning

PLEASE BRING THEIR FOOD & SNACKS

We know many of our dogs have specific food brands and meal plans they stick to so we ask all owners to ensure they bring along the food for their stay

If you do forget your dog's food, there is a £10p/day charge for meals, they will be fed hypo allergenic dry food at mealtimes

Our boarding is an open plan, at home style, bedding down with their best friends in various designated areas. If your dog does like to sleep in a crate at home, feel free to bring it along and we can place it in the living space with their door open at nighttime





BOARDING FAQs

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS...

How much notice do I need to give to book my dog in?

For existing recurring clients, you can book in with as little as a week's notice, availability dependent!

For new dogs, a minimum of 3 months in advance in order to have attended the daycare for at least x6 sessions (at company discretion if they may need more/less) – this way we get to know your dog and them us in return!

How do I book and when is payment due?

To book, please submit a boarding booking request form to hello@thelittledoggydaycare.co.uk You can request a booking form via WhatsApp or email. To confirm your booking, full payment is required. Payment is non-refundable due to the limited spaces available and advance bookings

Can I change or cancel my booking?

Due to limited spaces and advance bookings, dates are fixed once payment is received. However, we will always try our best to accommodate any date changes if necessary

What size dogs do you accept?

In line with our unique daycare format, we specialise in small breeds so accept dogs up to 15kg in weight, however if your dog is a small breed but a little heavier, please arrange a visit with us and we may be able to accept them

How many are there of you and what qualifications do you hold?

All our staff are qualified to either Level 2 or 3 Animal Management. Our team is currently 14 strong – we maintain our human to dog ratio at nighttime as well as during the day!

What do I need to send with my dog?

Please ensure you send your dog with the food and treats they need for their stay, all our dogs have specific meal plans or brands, so we want to ensure we keep their mealtimes exactly the same!

Please also feel free to send any beloved blankets and favourite toy or even a crate if your dog likes to sleep in theirs at home!

Can I book more than one dog in for boarding?

Absolutely, we have many family multiples – 2, 3 or even more, just ensure they each have their own profile on your account and book them in together

Does my male dog need to be neutered to board?

We kindly request that all male dogs over one year old are neutered. If your dog is not neutered for medical reasons, they may still be considered for boarding provided they do not display behaviours such as marking, mounting, fixation on other dogs (male or female), territorial tendencies, or aggression. During their initial time at daycare, our team will observe their behaviour to ensure they are suitable for our open, social environment. Once this assessment is complete and your dog is found to be a good fit, a boarding booking can then be confirmed
